

What is a total solar eclipse?

In a total solar eclipse, people who are in the path of totality see the Sun's bright disk totally covered by the Moon for a short time.

On April 8th, 2024 at 3:20pm, Rochester will be in direct path for 3 minutes and 38 seconds.

Based on traffic study patterns and the 2017 eclipse, 300,000-500,000 people are expected to come to Rochester and the surrounding areas to experience the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse.

A Total Solar Eclipse will not happen again in the Continental United States until 2044, in New York State until 2079, and in Rochester until 2144.

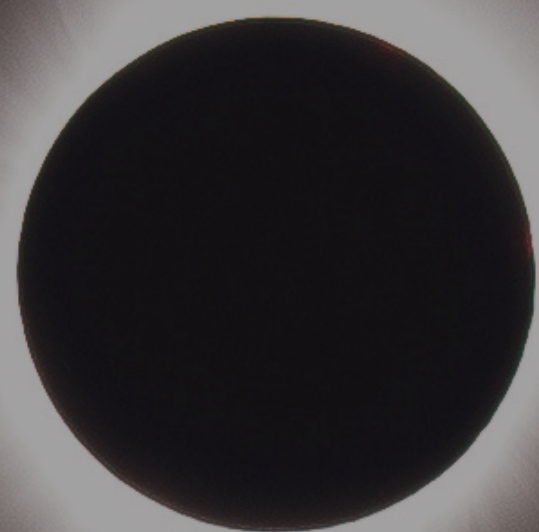
Saturday, April 6: Galactic Get Down

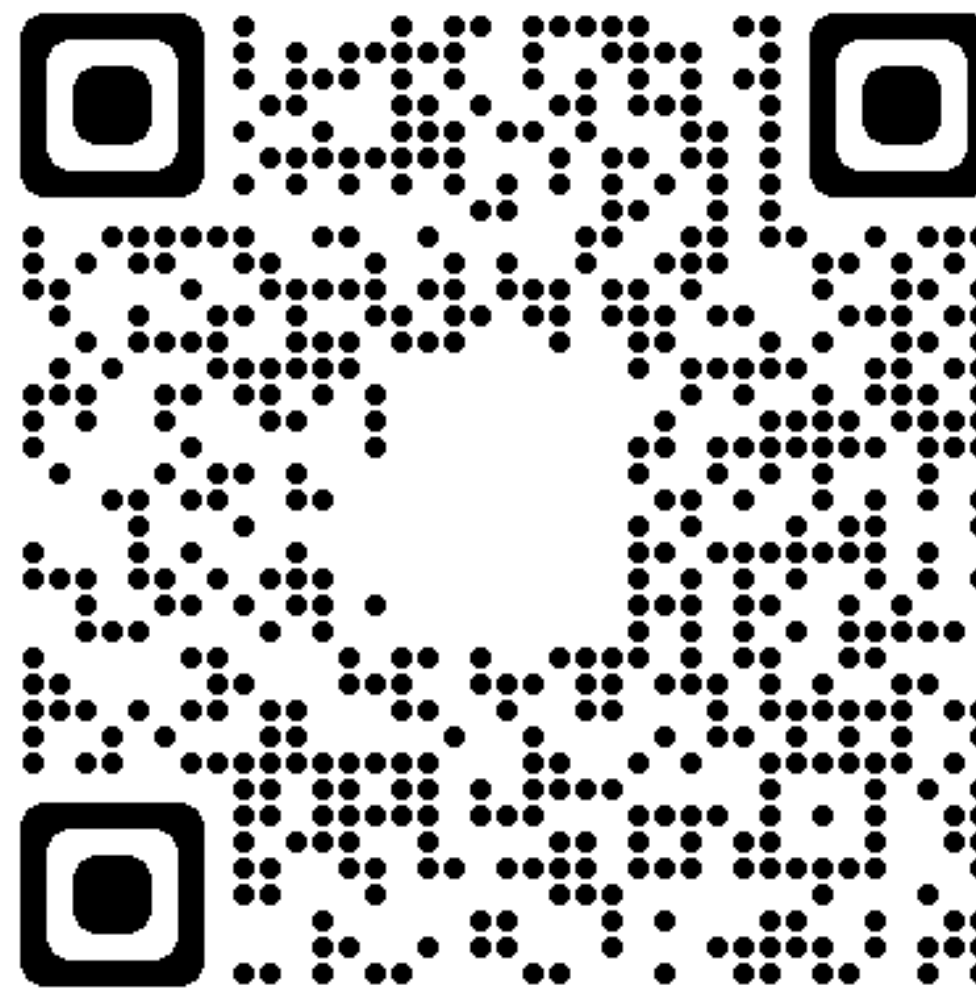
Saturday, April 6 - Monday, April 8: ROC The Eclipse Festival
