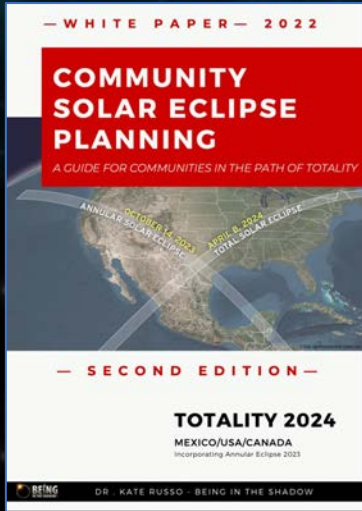

- Host high-profile projects to boost authority
- Consolidate region identity and establish a new narrative

A premium location along the path: *The first in the U.S.; near to the centerline; best weather along the path; in the eclipse crossroads for 2023 and 2024; in the ecological crossroads; a welcoming community; lots of space and something for everyone*

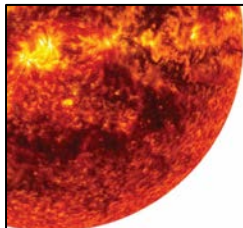

8:00AM - PREPARE FOR THE ECLIPSE
A variety of presentations and interactive activities for all ages are offered to help you prepare for the Annular Solar Eclipse. Create, learn, and practice before the eclipse begins.

10:15AM - 1:30PM - LET THE ECLIPSE BEGIN!
Guided viewing by an expert NASA solar researcher will help you and your family get the most from this experience. View safely through solar telescopes and solar eclipse glasses, and learn how to make and use indirect viewing methods. Take part in the many citizen science projects, or alternatively find a quiet place within the park to view in isolation.

1:30PM - 6PM - ECLIPSE REFLECTIONS & LEARNINGS
Share your eclipse experience and observations throughout the afternoon. More eclipse-related talks, workshops, and hands-on activities are on offer. Wander through the Solar, Lunar, and Eclipse Pavilions and talk to eclipse experts to gain confidence in planning for your own eclipse chase next April.

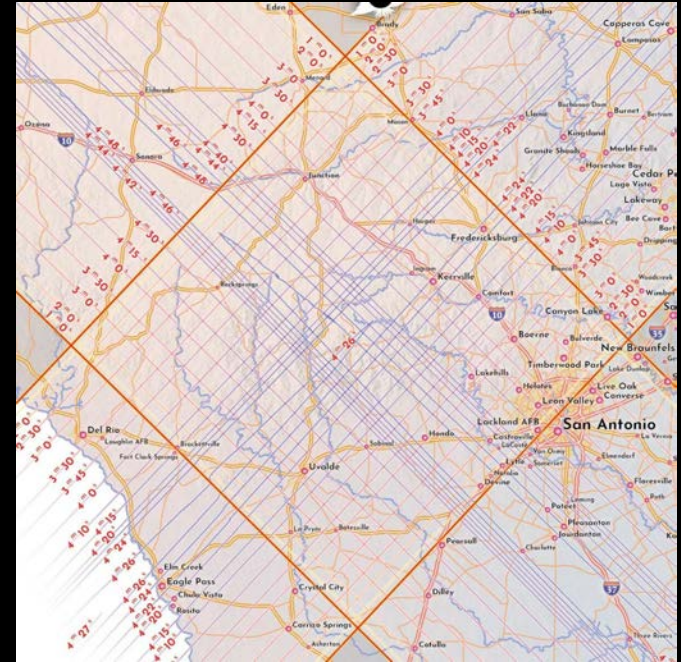

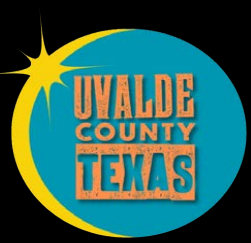
